

# Managing Git Repositories In AtScale

You can manage the Git repositories connected to your AtScale instance from the **Git Repositories** page under **Settings**.

## Add A New Repository

To add a new Git repository to AtScale:

1. In the main menu, select **Settings**.
2. In the **Settings** panel, click **Git Repositories**.
3. Click the plus icon.
4. In the **Add AtScale Git Repo** panel, complete the following fields:
  - ▲ **Repo name:** Enter a name for the repository to use within AtScale.
  - ▲ **URL:** Enter the URL for the repository.
5. Click **Save**.

## Edit A Repository

You can edit the name and URL for your repositories from within AtScale.

To edit an existing Git repository:

1. In the main menu, select **Settings**.
2. In the **Settings** panel, click **Git Repositories**.
3. Hover over the name of the repository in the list and click the pencil icon.
4. In the **Edit AtScale Git Repo** panel, edit the **Repo name** and **URL** as needed, then click **Save**.

## Remove A Repository From AtScale

To remove a repository from AtScale:

1. In the main menu, select **Settings**.
2. In the **Settings** panel, click **Git Repositories**.
3. Hover over the name of the repository in the list and click the delete icon.
