
## **About Global Vs Organization Properties**

System configuration properties can be set globally or per-organization. Global settings serve as the default across all organizations in your AtScale instance. Organization settings can override global settings for a particular organization.

The ability to view and manage global and/or organization configuration properties depends on your user role. To manage global properties, your user account must have the **Super User** permission. To manage organization-specific properties, your user account must be assigned to a role that has the **Organization Administrator** permission.

Users with **Super User** permission can manage properties in both places. At a best practice, the AtScale super user (admin user) should set system-wide defaults at the global level, and then allow organization administrators to override those defaults on an as-needed basis.

If you are logged in as **admin** (or another user with **Super User** permissions), pay attention to where you are setting configuration properties.



Non-super users will only be able to manage configuration properties within an organization (they won't see the **Global Settings** option).

Settings at the organization level always take precedence over global settings.

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
